

TERMS OF SALES

The general conditions of sale govern the contractual relations between any purchaser and Céline CARABAJAL "CARAZZO", residing 32 rue de la fontaine sasnières, 41800 VILLAVARD, FRANCE Siret number 50294906800022

1. **PRODUCT INFORMATION:** Each sculpture is a unique piece and could not be reproduced identically in the event of unavailability.
2. **PRICE:** The sale prices indicated are in euros and all taxes included. Packaging costs are included in the price. The shipping costs for mainland France are 8 to 13 euros including tax maximum depending on the weight & size of the package. For shipments outside mainland France and internationally, the shipping costs are 40 to 70 euros including tax, depending on the weight and the country. According to some countries, customs charges may be claimed by the customs administration in addition to the shipping costs.
3. **PAYMENT METHOD:** Payment will be made by bank transfer or via PAYPAL. Upon receipt of the transfer, the order will be shipped with the invoice and the manufacturing certificate.
4. **DELIVERY:** Upon receipt of payment, the sculpture will be packed in a suitable package and delivered to the transport company (colissimo by post) The sculpture will be sent to the address indicated under within 3 days. The purchaser will receive an e-mail specifying the tracking number of the delivery.
5. **EXCHANGE AND REIMBURSEMENT TERMS:** If the sculpture does not meet the expectations of the purchaser, the latter may return it at his expense and no later than seven days after the date of receipt, in its original packaging. 'origin, with the invoice, by the same carrier and service. Upon receipt of the sculpture and its good condition, the purchaser will be reimbursed the price of the sculpture.
6. **RESPONSIBILITY:** The artist cannot be held responsible in the event of disruption or total or partial strike, in particular postal services and means of transport or communications, flood, fire or war. The artist cannot be held responsible for the consequences resulting from the improper handling of the

acquired sculptures. The responsibility of the artist will, in any case, be limited to the amount of the order.

7. COPYRIGHT, WORKS RIGHTS: French law considers that the author of an intellectual work enjoys over this work, by the sole fact of his creation, an exclusive intangible property right that can be set up against all (article L.111.1 of the intellectual property code). The rights of the purchaser over the work are limited to private use, excluding any right of representation and reproduction, unless prior agreement is obtained.
